

# First Sunday of Advent - Year C - December 1, 2024 Readings for this week:

Jeremiah 33: 14-16; 1 Thessalonians 3:12-4:2; Luke 21: 25-28.

#### FRANCIS' FOCUS

#### Reflection by Nick Brodie



It is a time to stop 'dozing off' into spiritual apathy and indifference.

The Pope encourages us to use Advent to consider how we live our faith. Perhaps we have become too worldly, or spiritually insular? Maybe our prayers have become dull and routine, rather than heartfelt? Whatever the case, now is the moment to reflect on what really matters and act. Not tomorrow, not at Christmas, not after the holidays – Now!

There is an urgency to Advent, which this week's Gospel puts right in front of us. As Jesus says, we must be wakeful and alert! He speaks of things to do – stand, watch, pray – which shows us that the Christian life must be more than passive routines.

Framed by Jesus' call to his disciples, the Pope suggests that Advent should be spent 'looking beyond ourselves, expanding our mind and heart in order to open ourselves up to the needs of people, of brothers and sisters, and to the desire for a new world.' It is, he adds, 'a favourable time to open our hearts, to ask ourselves concrete questions about how and for whom we expend our lives.'

#### ST MARY'S PARISH RCIA UPDATE

Our parish RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) group has been underway for several weeks.

This Sunday (Dec 1) marks the next stage in the RCIA journey for those seeking to join the Catholic Church. At the 11.00 am Mass, the Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens will celebrated for those who are unbaptised.

The Rite of Welcome will be celebrated for those already baptised and preparing to be received into the Catholic Church ("Candidates").

From this Sunday Mass and until their full initiation into the Catholic Church next Easter, both Catechumens and Candidates are "dismissed" at the end of the Liturgy of the Word. The RCIA group and team leave the body of the Basilica to continue considering the significance of the Scripture readings for their faith journey.

**CONFIRMATION DATES** are early in March 2025 with classes commencing on Tuesday Feb. 4<sup>th</sup> 2025.
