

IMPORTANT EXTRA INFORMATION:

The Basilica will be closed to the public after the Midnight Mass & Christmas Day Masses, for Boxing Day and through until January 1st, 2025.

It will open only for the weekday 10am Mass on Saturday December 28th (*followed by Reconciliation*), Tuesday December 31st and Wednesday January 1st, 2025 – Solemnity of Mary.

The regular Weekday Mass times and dedications (Tuesday – Saturday at 10am) will begin on Thursday January 2nd, 2025, and the Basilica open hours will be Monday 10am – 5pm; Tuesday – Friday 9am – 5pm; and will open for the weekend Masses, Reconciliation, Baptisms and Weddings.

REGULAR SUNDAY MASSES will be celebrated on the weekend of Dec 28th/**29**th- see the front of Bulletin for full list of our regular Sunday Mass times.

PARISH OFFICE CLOSURE HOURS

The Parish Office will be closed from Tuesday December 24th at midday - 12 noon, 2024 for the Christmas/New Year break, and will re-open in the New Year at 9am on Thursday January 2nd, 2025.

'FRANCIS' FOCUS' (Reflection)

Pope Francis draws our attention to the way that Elizabeth greets Mary with joyful astonishment! He sees this an exemplar of how we should live our faith in this coming festive season.

We need to be astonished again!

'To celebrate Christmas in a fruitful manner,' the Pope says, 'we are called to pause in "places" of astonishment.'

He offers three examples of what this means.

Firstly, he draws attention to astonished recognition of other people. At a time of year when many of us will reunite with friends and family, we are called to see how 'every face is marked with a semblance to the Son of God.'

The **second** place of astonishment to which the Pope suggests we turn is 'history'. We need to look beyond markets and finances and see with faith the work of the Lord who exalts the lowly and uplifts the poor.

'The God of Christmas', the Pope quips, 'shuffles the cards' of history. Economics does not rule human destiny, God does.

Thirdly, we should find astonishment in 'the Church'. The Pope longs for us to embrace an understanding of the Church 'that is able to recognise the many signs of faithful love that God continuously sends her.' He hopes that 'Mother Church ... always has her doors open wide, and her arms open to welcome everyone.'
