





Baptism of our Lord Jesus Christ - Year C - January 12, 2025 Readings for this week:

Isaiah 42:1-4. 6-7; Acts of the Apostles 10:34-38; Luke 3:15-16.



Reflection - FRANCIS' FOCUS

Pope Francis draws our attention to a couple of interesting aspects of Jesus' baptism, which offer useful lessons for Christians today.

One of these is his humility. The Pope wants us to reflect on how remarkable it was that sinless Jesus was there among the crowds, 'joining the queue of the penitents, mingling among them.' The Son of God did not separate himself or seek special treatment!

The crowd which Jesus joined therefore shows us something profound about the Incarnation.

Being baptised among the common people, Jesus shows us what the Pope termed his 'willingness to immerse himself in the river of humanity.' Even the Lord of All does not lord it over ordinary folk! Nor then should we.

On another occasion, the Pope focuses our attention on Jesus' prayer life. In telling us how the Holy Spirit descended from heaven like a dove, Luke makes it clear that this happened while Jesus was praying. This, the Pope indicates, is an important point worthy of our contemplation: 'Jesus prays.'

'Prayer opens the heaven,' the Pope says, borrowing the image from today's Gospel. He then adds that prayer also 'enables us to have the same experience of Jesus by the Jordan: it makes us feel like beloved children of the Father.'

St Phillip Howard
Catholic Church,
Norfolk Island

A remote outpost of faith in the middle of the Pacific Ocean

– submitted by Diane Read, a St Mary's Parishioner

Norm and I have just returned after a weeklong holiday in Norfolk Island, a tiny island about 1,600 km ESE of Brisbane in the Pacific Ocean. I had always wanted to visit NI, the home of the descendants of the British sailors, led by Fletcher Christian, who mutinied against the command of Captain Bligh and commandeered the HMS "Bounty" in 1789 near Tahiti.

Norfolk Island's settlement of Kingston is now a World Heritage site, with several well-preserved buildings from its era as a Prison Colony from 1825 to 1855 set along beautiful and peaceful Emily Bay. My interest was sparked by information that my great-great grandfather, a British soldier, had been stationed on the Island from 1840 to 1845 guarding convicts imprisoned in the maximum-security prison, often for the term of their natural lives.

Norm and I located the St Phillip Howard Catholic Church – the most remote parish in the Archdiocese of Sydney – and were delighted to be able to attend Sunday Mass. With around twenty active parishioners, this parish has been without a priest since 1987, and relies on visiting clergy to offer Mass. Most weeks, however, the parish offers a communion service. On our visit on 5 January, we were blessed to have His Grace, the Most Rev Julian Porteous, Archbishop of Hobart, offer the Mass. This was a wonderful experience for us, especially when Archbishop Porteous mentioned he would be calling into Geelong to board the Spirit of Tasmania.




