REMEMBRANCE DAY - November 11

Remembrance Day is held on the anniversary of the Armistice that ended the war with Germany in WWI. The Armistice agreement was signed between Germany and the Allied Forces in Paris on Monday, 11 November 1918 at 0500 hours. The ceasefire went into effect at 1100 hours the same morning - at 11am on 11 November 1918, the guns on the Western Front fell silent after more than four years of continuous warfare. Known as Armistice Day.

After the Second World War, the Australian Government agreed to the United Kingdom's proposal that Armistice Day be renamed Remembrance Day to commemorate those who were killed in both World Wars.

Today the loss of Australian lives from all wars and conflicts is commemorated on Remembrance Day, and on the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month, one minute's silence is observed and dedicated to those soldiers who died fighting to protect the nation.

What does "Lest we Forget" mean? The phrase is borrowed from a line in a well-known poem written in the 19th century, the phrase 'lest we forget' means 'it should not be forgotten'. We say or write 'lest we forget' in commemorations to remember always the service and sacrifice of people who have served in wars, conflicts and peacekeeping operations.

Are red poppies for Anzac Day or Remembrance Day?

The first red poppies to come to Australia, in 1921, were made in France. In Australia, in past times single poppies were not *usually* worn on ANZAC Day, as the poppy belongs to Remembrance Day. However, these days, single poppies and wreaths of poppies are traditionally placed at memorials and honour boards on both ANZAC Day and Remembrance Day.
