PARISH CENSUS FORMS – LET'S TRY THIS AGAIN...

A review of the Census form has taken place this week. Our sincere apologies for this inconvenience, we are starting over and ask **all** our parishioners, even those who filled out the cards last week, to fill out the new forms that we believe are much easier to understand and have been designed to collect all the information we need to update our parish data records. The process is as follows:

- 1. For the next three weeks, our **Welcomers will hand out the Census Forms in the Narthex as you enter for Mass and again after the Homily**, when those who missed out on collecting a form will be given the opportunity to raise your hand, indicating you require a form. It will be brought to you.
- 2. Extra copies will be available for pick-up on top of the grey Census Dropbox in the Narthex. We encourage you to take the form home to complete; write in clear printed letters and return it to us via the grey Dropbox or to the Parish Office the following week or weekend. If you wish to complete the forms during Mass, please take the time to write in clear printed letters.

NOTE: Both sides of the form are required to be filled out.

- 3. Please do not place the completed forms in the Collection Bags at the First & Second Collection at Sunday Masses. Completed forms can be dropped in the grey Census Dropbox in the Narthex, or at the Parish Office.
- 4. **Only one form per household is required.** If you have more members than the spaces provided on the form, please fill out another form and staple them together after completion for submission.

Reflection on the Gospel

Jesus reminds us in this gospel that to join him in bringing about the reign of God requires absolute commitment and a willingness to give up that which is most precious to us. The rich man who approached Jesus was genuine in his desire to fulfil all the requirements of the Law to attain eternal life.

Jesus quoted to him all the commandments that deal with right relationships with others.

The man is able to tick these off and assure Jesus that he has been doing this since childhood – a pretty big claim in the first place!

Then Jesus 'looked steadily at him and loved him' – he looked on him with the eyes of love; the eyes that see to the heart of a person, and in that look knew what was most important to the man. Jesus could tell by his dress no doubt that the man was wealthy and so it is this aspect of the man's life that Jesus chooses to challenge him about.

This gospel shouldn't necessarily be read as a condemnation of wealth – rather, it is the man's inability to surrender his wealth that Jesus challenges. Jesus sees to the heart of the man and asks if he is willing to give up that which is most important in his life. The man is unable to do what Jesus asks of him and goes away sad. Why sad?

He's sad because he knows that he has been tested and failed. He knows that what he genuinely desired was within his reach but he needed to let go of his position, his status, his wealth, to be able to grasp what he desired in both hands.
